Tulsa mobile company to add jobs

TULSA MOBILE COMPANY TO ADD JOBS

A [Tulsa](#)-based mobile business solutions company that just went public will add 170 employees during the next five years after joining the state's Quality Jobs program.

[MacroSolve Inc.](#), the parent company of Anyware Mobile Solutions, is experiencing a growth spurt that saw revenues jump 43 percent in the second quarter. Revenues

grew to \$2.3 million in 2007, a 66 percent increase over fiscal year 2006 revenues of \$1.4 million.

'A one-stop shop'

The company has 30 employees and provides mobile data and mobile video solutions for small- and medium-size businesses which typically don't have IT staff to create systems inhouse, [President and Chief Executive Clint Parr](#) said. MacroSolve helps businesses go wireless and creates, integrates and installs the needed software and hardware. "We're a one-stop shop for mobile systems," Parr said.

MacroSolve will need to expand its staff with Web developers, IT staffers, sales, marketing and product marketing employees, as well as telemarketers. Salaries vary, but the median wage comes in at about \$75,000 a year, with benefits, he said. "We're recruiting right now."

MacroSolve has clients across the country and in [Canada](#), and an office in [Dallas](#). Within the next year, "We are looking to expand into [Oklahoma City](#)," Parr said.

The company's expansion is also behind the creation of a community-commerce Web site aimed at pointing small businesses to the purchase, sale and servicing of mobile systems.

MacroSolve is now trading under the symbol MCVE and is being traded on the [OTC Bulletin Board](#), Parr said.

Going public will allow the company build a public value, he said, and to make acquisitions that will expand the company even further.

Through the Quality Jobs program, MacroSolve will receive \$4.5 million in payroll rebates if it adds the promised number of jobs within five years, the [Commerce Department](#) said.
